The Lake County Public Health Department is accepting applications for:

Home Visitor/Parent Educator

QUALIFICATIONS: Must possess an Associate's Degree in Nursing, a Montana RN license, and 1 year of experience in maternal child health/home visiting, conducting developmental assessments and health screenings, education or prenatal development and postpartum health OR possess a Bachelors in Early Childhood Education; must possess a valid Montana driver's license; must have effective oral and written communication skills, the ability to work flexible hours, align with the basic principles of public health, and travel to meetings and trainings; and must be skilled in computer use. An Associate's Degree in Early Childhood Education or a related field and supervised experience working with young children and/or parents will also be considered.

DUTIES: Provide home visiting services to High Risk Families; utilize appropriate screening tools; document all visits; collaborate with other team members for comprehensive Home Visiting Services; engage in breastfeeding education and outreach activities; work non-judgmentally with all clients; fulfill reporting requirements/data collection and assessment; link clients to Healthy Montana Kids, Presumptive Eligibility for Medicaid, and other area resources; represent the department on community coalitions, at special events, meetings, etc.; attend meetings and trainings; meet with Home Visiting Supervisor; and perform other duties as assigned.
