Mechanic

QUALIFICATIONS: Must possess a formal certificate, or 2 years of hands on experience, a valid Montana Commercial Driver's License with Class A minimum, and an acceptable driving record. Must be knowledgeable of materials, methods, tools and equipment used in testing, adjustment, repair, and overhaul of all types of equipment and vehicles; and of road construction and maintenance methods to include grading, plowing, sanding, patching and chip sealing. Must possess the ability to understand and follow directions and establish and maintain good working relationships.

DUTIES: Repair, maintain, overhaul, and fabricate parts for vehicles and equipment; operate acetylene and electric welding equipment; assist operators with maintenance and diagnosis of equipment problems; travel to work sites to repair equipment and make adjustments as necessary; operate trucks, graders, loaders, rollers and tractors for road maintenance and construction; perform manual labor for signing, patching, fencing and related work; clear debris from roads, bridges and culverts; perform operator maintenance on equipment; and perform other maintenance duties as assigned.
