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### **ADDITIONAL APPLICATION REQUIREMENT**

#### **Minimum Standards for Licensure** **(MCA 37-40-302 & ARM 24.216.502)**

Along with the Lake County application, please include information to demonstrate that you meet one of the following minimum requirements as given in the Position Description.

1. Current licensure as a Montana Registered Sanitarian. Provide documentation of your registration.
2. A bachelor's degree in environmental health from an accredited college or university. Provide documentation. Include an official or unofficial copy of your college transcripts.
3. A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university including a minimum of 45 quarter or 30 semester hours in the physical and biological sciences, including courses in chemistry, biology and at least one general microbiology course as an equivalent qualification of a bachelor's degree in environmental health as required by the MCA and, as determined by the Montana Board of Sanitarians. Complete the back of this page to demonstrate this equivalency. Include an official or unofficial copy of your college transcripts.

NOTE: Applicants who meet the requirements under Item 3 with the exception of a general microbiology course will be required to successfully complete a course in Microbiology within the probationary period as a requirement to meet licensure as a Montana Registered Sanitarian. This can be done while employed under Sanitarian-In-Training status.
