

(0) ~~Fencing, Stairways, Satellite Antennas, Sun Decks and Walkways~~ *split into two sections*

(1) Policy

- (a) ~~Fences or hedges~~ within the lakeshore protection zone restrict the free movement of people and wildlife and may detract from the aesthetic value of the lakeshore.
- (b) Fences are discouraged within the lakeshore protection zone and should only be allowed in necessary situations such as where residential property abuts a more intense use such as a park, resort or commercial operation.
- (c) ~~Fences or hedges may be permitted within the lakeshore protection zone provided that they do~~ should not restrict the visibility of the neighboring properties ~~or extend water ward of the mean annual high water elevation.~~

(2) Standards

- (a) Fences within the lakeshore protection zone shall only be allowed where a private residential property abuts a park, resort, commercial use or other incompatible use. Exceptions may be made in cases where special circumstances warrant additional consideration.
- (b) No fence shall exceed six feet (6') in height within the lakeshore protection zone.
- (~~b~~c) All fences must maintain at least fifty percent (50%) open space in their design. Solid fences are prohibited.
- (~~e~~d) Barbed-wire fencing is prohibited.
- (~~d~~e) Fences shall not extend water ward of the mean annual high water elevation.
