

Pump Houses / Water Pump Enclosures

Comment [1]: Most of the language comes from Missoula County's lakeshore protection regulations

(1) Policy

- (a) Pump houses or enclosures to protect a water pump are often necessary.
- (b) Pump houses can detract from the aesthetic values of the lakeshore if not properly designed and/or screened from neighbors and lake users' views.

(2) Standards

- (a) Pump houses shall be located above the mean annual high water elevation.
- (b) The size of a new pump house shall not exceed four feet (4') by four feet (4') by four feet (4').
- (c) Pump houses shall be constructed with non-reflective materials
- (d) Pump houses shall be screened with vegetation or designed and constructed with natural colors which blend with the background landscape.
