The Planning Board and Planning Department staff will conduct a public meeting to initiate the process to correct, update, amend, and revise the Lake Mary Ronan Zoning District and Regulations and potentially the surrounding development density designations on the Lake County Density Map. This will be a public work session to review the existing regulations and obtain comment related to upcoming proposed amendments and the process. Following the September public meeting, the Planning Department staff will begin drafting updated regulations and preparing draft zoning district maps for public review observing the required procedures for county zoning outlined by MCA 76-2-205.
