## Lake County requires proper waste separation

Following a recommendation from the Board of Directors of the Lake County Solid Waste District to change disposal fees to cover increased costs of operation, the Board of Lake County Commissioners signed Resolution 21-32 (a) revising the Solid Waste Management District Disposal Fees.

Effective February 1, 2022, disposal fees are as follows:

- Wood Waste Properly separated for disposal at the Class III Landfill
  - \$15.00 per ton
  - Large Stumps and other difficult to handle materials are \$40.00 per ton
- Construction and Demolition Debris properly separated for disposal at the Class IV Landfill
  - \$10.00 per cubic yard
  - \$10.00 minimum charge
- Concrete without rebar and properly separated for disposal at Class III Landfill
  - \$20.00 per ton
- Large Animal disposal at the Transfer Station
  - \$80.00 per ton
- PAYT (Pay as You Throw) - non-assessed waste, disposed of at the Transfer Station
  - \$80.00 per ton
  - \$10.00 minimum
- Loads not properly separated for disposal
  - \$150.00 per ton at Transfer Station or Class III Landfill
  - \$50.00 per yard at the Class IV Landfill
- Special Handling of Other Large Waste Volumes
  - Fee set by mutual agreement between Lake County and Contractor, Waste Generator, or Waste Hauler

**THE WASTES LISTED ABOVE MAY NOT BE DISPOSED OF AT LAKE COUNTY CONTAINER SITES.** Violations are actively pursued. Disposal fees are due upon disposal, unless billing arrangements are made prior to disposal. Credit cards are not accepted.

## Use the following list to help separate your waste

### Lake County Container Sites - Open 7AM-7PM – Daily, except legal holidays

- Household type waste only, in household quantities
- Dead Animals under 200 pounds
- Locations:
  - Woods Bay – 14692 Sylvan Drive
  - Ferndale – 13003 Hwy 83
  - Swan – 25781 Hwy 83 – **Open Saturday and Tuesday – 8:30 – 3:30**
  - Proctor – 45642 Lake Mary Ronan Rd, Proctor, MT 59929
  - Charlo – 55633 Herak Rd
  - Ravalli – 66972 N Valley Creek Rd
- Container sites are for use only by those that pay the Lake County Solid Waste Fee
- Unacceptable materials are listed on signs at the sites

### Lake County Transfer Station - (406) 883-7323

#### Class II (Decomposable) wastes including:

- Household waste, garbage, and other biodegradable materials
- Clothing, Books, Small appliances, etc.
- Dead Animals
- Small amounts of household hazardous wastes
  - Such as paint, cleansers, pesticides
- No Liquids

#### Recyclable items:

- Used motor oil and anti-freeze, lead batteries, tires
- Cardboard, newspapers, mixed residential paper, aluminum, and steel cans
- Plastic bottles – separate your #1 & #2 Milk Jugs – Remove lids
- Metal separated and placed in the scrap metal
  - Separate out appliances that had or have Freon

#### Class III (Inert landfill next to Transfer Station) wastes include:

- Untreated, unglued, unpainted wood waste or lumber materials
  - **(NO plywood, OSB, or particleboard)**
- Concrete (without exposed rebar)
- Rock
- Brick (Unpainted)
- Brush, tree trimmings, and stumps

39276 Kerr Dam Road, Open 8AM -5PM, Tuesday through Saturday, except legal holidays.

#### Class IV (Construction & Demolition) wastes including:

- Painted or treated wood (Includes plywood, OSB, and particleboard)
- Gypsum Board (Dry Wall)
- Insulation
- Asphalt Shingles
- Asphalt (banned from Class III Landfills)
- Large furniture items, such as sofas, mattresses, or wooden dressers

#### Compostable Material:

- Grass Clippings, Garden Waste, Leaves, Manure, Crop Residues (go to compost pile)
