### **How are home schoolers using EdReady?**

Homeschoolers can use EdReady in a variety of ways. Some parents have their children use EdReady every morning for several hours, as they work through their individualized learning paths. Other parents have their children work for shorter time periods—for thirty minutes or so. As one parent puts it, “We can even slip math in on a Saturday for a thirty-minute practice.
