

## Body Art Establishments: COVID-19 Operational Phases

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PHASE 1</b></p> <p>Tattoo, body piercing, etc.</p> 	<p><b>OPERATORS</b></p> <p>Required</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 6 feet distance or physical barrier between stations</li> <li>• Waiting areas closed</li> <li>• Frequently touched surfaces be cleaned and sanitized as often as possible</li> <li>• Screen worker and patron forehead temperature and/or screen for symptoms.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Symptoms of concern include fever, shortness of breath, and frequent cough</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Recommended best practices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clients by appointment only</li> <li>• Follow normal use and sterilization procedures for multi-use utensils and equipment between patrons</li> <li>• Follow normal use and disposal procedures for single-service articles</li> <li>• Prohibit non-essential worker and visitor access onto premises if possible</li> <li>• Consider signage for patrons directing patrons to maintain 6 feet distance between people not in their immediate group</li> <li>• Do not perform procedures on customers showing signs of illness</li> <li>• Workers experiencing symptoms should consult with a primary care provider or their local health department</li> <li>• Shielding protection between guest and front-desk worker</li> <li>• Train workers for:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Sanitation and hygiene procedures</li> <li>○ COVID-19 symptom awareness</li> <li>○ Incident response plan for cleaning and sanitizing regarding a positive COVID-19 test or case</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>BODY ARTISTS</b></p> <p>Required</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimize contact time with patrons when possible</li> </ul> <p>Recommended best practices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Beware of illness symptoms</li> <li>• Wear surgical face mask if possible</li> <li>• Face coverings should remain in place until procedure is complete and customer has left the establishment</li> <li>• Any procedures that cannot be completed with customer face covering remaining in place should be avoided e.g. face tattoos and nose piercings</li> <li>• Follow normal use and disposal procedures for single-use gloves</li> <li>• Wash hands when contaminated or suspected of contamination</li> <li>• Report illness symptoms to operator</li> <li>• Do not work, stay home if ill</li> </ul> <p><b>PATRONS</b></p> <p>Recommended Best Practices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vulnerable people to COVID-19 should not use body art services at this time</li> <li>• Wear surgical face mask or facial cloth covering if possible</li> <li>• Prior to handling any documents, pens, or surfaces, the customer should sanitize their hands using hand sanitizer provided by the establishment when available</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PHASE 2</b></p> <p>The same as PHASE 1 with changes in adjacent column</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NO CHANGES FROM PHASE 1</b></p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>PHASE 3</b></p> <p>The same as PHASE 2 with changes in adjacent column</p>	<p><b>CHANGES FROM PHASE 2</b></p> <p>Required</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Total seating capacity may increase to normal capacity</li> </ul> <p>Recommended Best Practices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Waiting area can be opened</li> <li>• Walk-in customers can resume</li> </ul>
