Approve June Meeting Notes – Grant made motion, Connie 2nd, Approved
Comments from Public – Dayton Community Members present

1. Dayton Park –
 - a. Pam had concerned that the building with Cistern had been left unlocked, leaving County liable with open cistern. Board recommended that a number combination lock for key storage is installed. Leaving key on location and access to only those with code. Smith septic pumps out cistern every three years. Scheduled for spring 2020.
 - b. Discussion about placement of Ball Hoop on grass. Marvin felt it limited kids playing baseball on field. Pam felt families were using hoop for basketball. Board recommended polling Dayton members to discern what activities they wanted in their park.
 - c. Parking on east side still an issue.
 - d. Garbage pickup at park trash cans no longer working. Garbage cans not being emptied, and garbage is being left beside cans. Pam asked to have fewer cans set out to decrease disposal work. Board approved motion to cut back on cans.
 - e. Pam asked to pour concrete under picnic tables to help with mowing. Pam will schedule and provide labor if board pays for concrete. Board agreed.
 - f. House next to swim park is asking for barrier rope to be cut in one section so that residents may reach lake shore more easily. Marvin feels this is a good choice. Board gave go ahead to open one section of rope for access.
2. Recreational Access Partnership –
 - a. Commissioners did not do anymore review over summer. Board strongly recommended they look over the partnership paperwork as this fits into Park Board plan. To be discussed at next meeting.
3. Rainbow Drive Update –
 - a. The cooler summer reduced use at Rainbow Drive. The few hot days did see large crowds. Ferndale Market is offering shuttles to reduce parking issues. Some concern about commercial use of area. Grant working with Wally on long-term parking solution.
 - b. A small fence repair is needed. Hornets are inside sign; be careful when opening. Sign did not leak this summer.
4. Work Day Review – Will schedule next spring. Things look good at this time.
