Approve November Meeting Notes:

Comments from Public:

Pam O'Mara shared a signed statement from 35 Dayton community members stating that all were happy to leave the Basketball hoop where it was. Any future recreational changes, the board recommends surveying community members regarding the park needs and uses. Recommended spraying weeds for park, Spring 2020. Other Dayton news: Fireman's Dock needs to be looked at and repaired, refurbished, or replaced. Commissioners will follow up on need.

Discussion Points:

Rainbow Drive Completion – Heidi Fleury unavailable Lauren Odem, Lake County Watershed, presented in her place. Embankment was still washing away from overuse. Group came in with revegetation this fall. Beautiful restoration work completed. Photos will be placed on website. Recommended setting another step to decrease future erosion. Grant will work with Denny first. Park board approves spending needed funds to place step. More fencing may be needed. Grant will also work with Jay to place new signs about restoration and staying off river bank. Lauren and crew will plant grass for stabilization in the spring.

Recreational Access Partnership: Postponed until December meeting with commissioners at meeting

Parks Map Inventory – Commissioners will work with GSI for maps of trails.

Potential Land Donation to Lake County: Gale shared where two small sections of land between eastside of HWY 93 and the bike trail is being donated to County. Sections have little park value but provides a buffer for bike trail and lake view. Park Board in favor of accepting donation.
